The **2008 Fuel Discount Program** includes a **Member Per Gallon Discount** of \$.20 a gallon on all gas and diesel purchased at the NBYC Fuel Dock. Members who expect to purchase more than 500 gallons between May 1, 2008 and October 31, 2008 should ask to have their name added to the **Member Volume Discount** list which will add an additional \$.05 a gallon from 500 to 799 gallons; \$.10 a gallon from 800 to 1199 gallons; \$.15 a gallon from 1200 to 1999 gallons; and \$.20 a gallon over 2000 gallons. The volume discount is cumulative and the combined savings is especially good if you tank up with over 2000 gallons! Note: If you have signed up for the volume discount list, you must tell the dock attendant to record your purchase on the volume list each time you fuel. We are also offering a Guest Volume Discount to high volume purchasers.
